

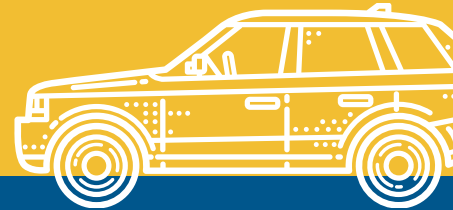
# EXPLORING TRANSPORTATION AND STEM: FROM THE COMMUNITY TO THE CLASSROOM
